The Bishops of the United States have approved a special onetime second collection to take place in parishes across the nation to support the mosaic ornamentation of the *Trinity Dome*, the crowning jewel of the *Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception*. The National Shrine has been a century in the making since the laying of its foundation stone in 1920. Your generous support will help complete a beautiful mosaic that will adorn the Trinity Dome of America's Catholic Church in Washington, DC. St. Martin De Porres and St. Katharine Drexel are two of several saints that will be included in the artwork.

The completion of the Trinity Dome in preparation for the *100th anniversary* of the *laying* of the *foundation stone* of the National Shrine in **2020** is a monumental undertaking.
