### Second Sunday of Easter Deacon's Corner

Dear Holy Spirit Family,

Let me start by thanking all of our Liturgical Ministers, our Acolytes, Lectors, Ministers of Holy Communion, our Greeters/ Ushers, our choir, our Sign Ministry and our Praise Dancers. You serve our God and our parish with exemplary dedication. You are faithful to your ministry and are an example of service. I personally cannot thank you enough.

We have a wonderful parish. There were those who doubted that our three parishes could come together and truly become one parish. We have proven those doubters wrong and have become an example of faith and trust in God.

We still need the help of our parishioners, and particularly our teens and young adults, to become engaged in our ministries. Due to the age of some of our ministers who are willing but unable to serve, the number of our active ministers is dwindling. On Saturday evening we have no men serving as Lectors or Ministers of Holy Communion at the 4:00pm Mass. The same holds true for our 8:30am Mass on Sunday.

On Saturday we have two acolytes, seven lectors, six ministers of Holy Communion and 8 greeters/ushers.

For our 8:30 Mass on Sunday, we have two adults and two teen acolytes; three lectors and three Ministers of Holy Communion.

For our 10:15 Mass, we have three adult and seven teen acolytes; 25 lectors; 24 Ministers of Holy Communion and nineteen greeters/ ushers. We need at least three acolytes; two lectors and five Ministers of Holy Communion for each of the Sunday Masses.

Don't forget, many of our adults serve in more than one ministry which limits their availability for service in other ministries. Also, we have only one person serving in the ministry of sacristan.

We need parishioners to serve in all of our ministries. Our ministries are open to men and women, girls and boys. When our teens graduate from elementary or high school, many cease their service to our parish.

If we are going to remain the welcoming, vibrant and faith-filled parish, a parish of continued growth, the parish that we are, we need parishioners willing to serve. Listen to your hearts to see if the voice of the Lord is calling you to service.

If you hear the calling or feel the urge to serve, call the office or see Brother Mick, Deacon Shelby or Deacon Ron.
