**Fasting:** On Good Friday, those who are 18 but not yet 59 are allowed only one full meal. Two smaller meals are allowed as needed, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

**Abstinence from Meat:** Those who are 14 years of age or older are to abstain from meat the Fridays of Lent.
