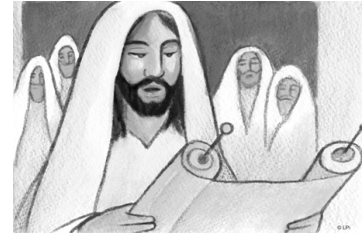


*Holy Spirit Parish
