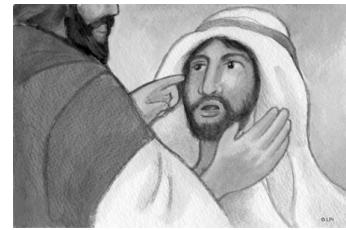




**Holy Spirit Parish

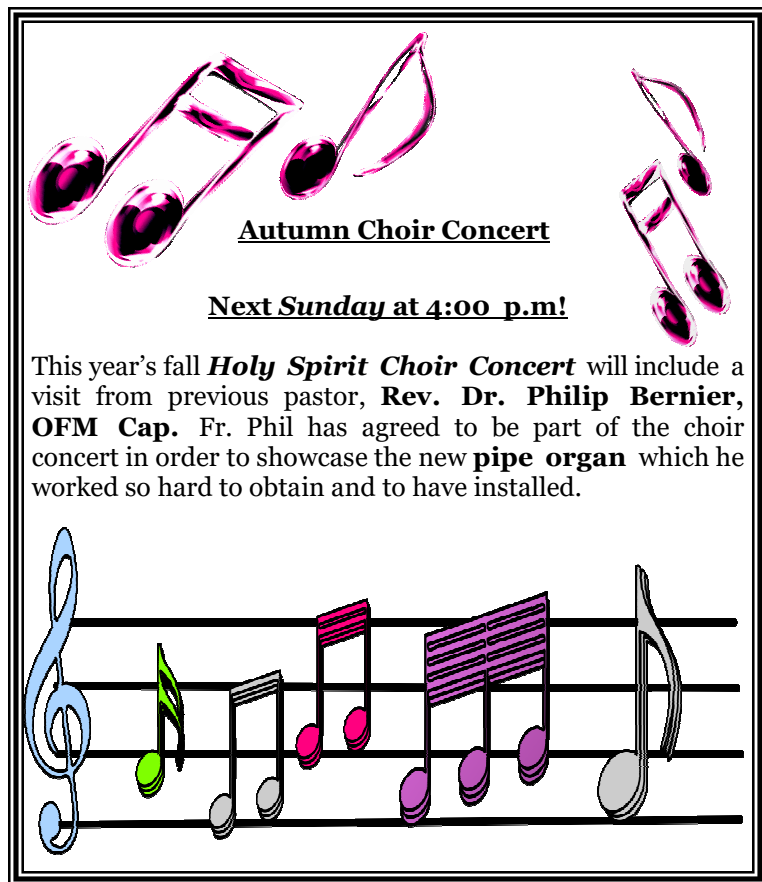
