**CATHOLIC CHARITIES IN-PEW APPEAL
NEXT WEEKEND**

From a letter by Bishop Nelson Pérez:

“The opioid epidemic is crushing families and communities throughout Northeast Ohio. Parishioners want to be part of the solution and rightfully look to Catholic Charities, which is on the frontline in treating people in the grip of addiction.

“Today, I am asking you to present the Catholic Charities 2018 follow-up in-pew appeal over the May 19th weekend to your parishioners. This follow-up appeal will focus on raising funds to treat people fighting opioid addiction. This appeal has a very important message — one that is especially relevant to life and saving lives in Northeast Ohio.

“The follow-up in-pew appeal has proven to be a critical part of the Catholic Charities annual appeal’s success over the past several years. Last year, we collectively raised more than \$780,000 from over 6300 donors during this follow-up appeal which included gifts from nearly 4000 donors who had never given to Catholic Charities before. As in last year’s follow-up appeal, every gift made next weekend will be matched, dollar for dollar, up to \$100,000.”

A TRAGEDY IN THE CAPUCHIN WORLD



Br. Saúl Soriano died during emergency surgery in the early hours of Monday morning. Br. Saúl was 31 years old and professed perpetual vows as a Capuchin last August. Originally from El Salvador, he was completing theological studies in Washington, D.C. and had a dream of becoming an immigration lawyer in order to serve refugees and migrants from Latin America fleeing violence from gangs and oppressive governments. He had a very kind heart and a gentle spirit. He suffered a bicycling accident that resulted in ruptured arteries in both of his legs.
