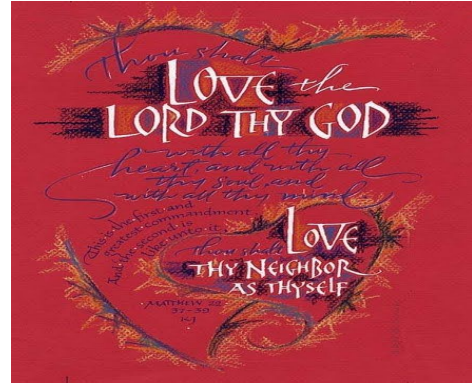
FR. JOHN WRIGHT
