**SUPPORTING ONE OF OUR OWN
AND, MORE IMPORTANTLY, THOSE IN GREAT NEED**

Sunni Wenson is the daughter of our own Shirley Wenson and a volunteer with the Peace Corps in Zambia, Africa. Sunni is leading a project to build a Mothers' Shelter to provide a safe place for baby deliveries, prenatal and postnatal care, and monthly monitoring for children up to five years old.

To get the project off the ground and bring it to fruition, the Mothers' Shelter needs \$2,600.10. A blueprint for the bidding exists as well as a list of required materials. Land has been contributed, local people will provide the labor. Upon completion of this project, the Mothers' Shelter will provide health services within a closer proximity for the residents of the locality as well as four surrounding villages.

You can donate in two ways:

1. by offering a check, made payable to "Peace Corps Partnership Program" and giving it directly to Shirley Wenson to be delivered by Fed Ex to the Peace Corps, or;
2. by visiting this website and making your donation electronically: www.peacecorps.gov/donate. And then, under "Donate," and then, "View All Volunteers," search for "Wenson" or "Zambia." You should find it with a small amount of effort.

The parish's Ministry of Mercy Fund is making a donation of \$200.
