dfree is back. It is a 12-week faith-based financial freedom and education series that focuses on reducing debt, growing wealth and achieving financial freedom. SMART ACADEMY

You may have noticed some activity in our school building here on Cranwood Avenue. SMART Academy has signed a lease with the Diocese of Cleveland for five years to begin a charter school focusing on literacy. It will be open to students from kindergarten through third grade. Their goal is to open with 100 students.


In order for the academy to obtain an occupancy permit, the parish must replace the secondary boiler; that project has been approved by the diocese and a new boiler is on its way. There will be other expenses on our behalf in order to honor the lease. So while there are some initial and significant expenses up front, we now have a paying tenant in the building and in time we will begin to earn some modest income from the building.

The gymnasium will still be available to us during off-school hours for events like our parish picnic and other occasions. The first day of school is August 13.
