PSR / PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION
The PSR program will follow the same plan as we have become accustomed to — a three-hour day on every second Saturday of the month beginning with breakfast at 8:30 am; class begins at 9:00 am and ends at Noon. Mrs. Reiko Simmons has agreed to take over the leadership role of the PSR. The first PSR class will be on Saturday, September 8.

FIRST COMMUNION / CONFIRMATION CLASSES
A schedule of classes for First Communion and Confirmation is not yet finalized, but an announcement will be coming shortly.

Last Thursday evening there was a meeting of teachers and aides in order to get a first look at the possibility of adopting a new curriculum.

Also, we are considering a 3 and 4 year old class — if we have enough students, we will open a new grade level. Please register.

One of the most compelling reasons to take part in PSR is to build relationships among fellow parishioners so that the strong community we have now will thrive into future generations.
