

SEVERAL BIG REPAIRS ARE COMPLETE

Beginning last summer we undertook several expensive and extensive repairs on our property and buildings. We began by replacing one of the two boilers in the school building as Smart Academy was preparing to open. Just recently the new system of boiler controls for the church has been completed. Three flat roofs on the church have been totally replaced (over the chapel, over the choir room, and over the sacristy). All the interior damage from those leaky roofs has been repaired. The roof on the parish center has been repaired as well as interior damage related to that leak. We have restored parking lot lighting, and made some repairs on the parking lot surface itself. All of this amounts to \$180.191.01.

We were able to afford this because over the years we have built up some significant savings. At our last meeting, the parish's finance council discussed a strategy to rebuild our investment fund so that we are prepared for the next rainy day. Having completed paying the realtor who helped us find a tenant for the school building, and now that we are beginning to see some income from the renting of the building, we are planning on putting approximately \$3000 every month back into our investment fund.
