Passion Sunday is the beginning of the holiest of days on the church's calendar. Please note the schedule of liturgies for the week; it's a bit out of the ordinary.



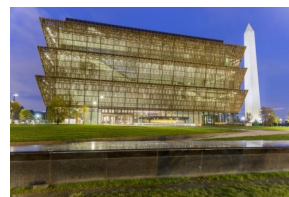
While none of the celebrations this week (except for Easter Sunday) are considered obligatory for Catholics, they remain the most special and significant of the entire year.

**AFRICAN AMERICAN MUSEUM TRIP

Plans for our parish trip to the African American Museum in August 2019 are developing. The dates are set.

We need a minimum of 42 people to guarantee the trip and lock in the prices. So, reservations are open. Please call the rectory and leave a voice message to reserve a place for the trip.

The price is \$407 per person. This is based on double-occupancy for the hotel for two nights, museum fees, and it includes 5 meals in the nation's capital while we are there. A single-occupancy room is \$567. A triple-occupancy accommodation is \$373 per person. Each participant will be responsible for other meals and incidentals along the way.
