


The conversation was always respectful of each one's experience and opinion. No one's remarks were cut short; each one was listened to with reverence. The sharing was heartfelt.



Our own Deacon Shelby Friend is featured in the July/August edition of the Northeast Cleveland Ohio Catholic Magazine. The article begins with, "From humble beginnings in Greeneville, TN to a stint in the army, relocation to Cleveland, marriage (42 years to his wife Maxine), a family (3 children) and ordination as a permanent deacon (celebrating 25 years this past spring), Deacon Shelby has lived a full

life". The article highlights how food was always a constant. As early as 7 years old Deacon Shelby began learning culinary arts from his father who was chef at country clubs and hotels in Greeneville, TN when things were made from scratch.

Additional highlights include: serving 3 years in the army in Vietnam for which he earned a Purple Heart; continuing on his culinary journey returning to Greeneville, TN as a chef in country clubs and hotels; working as a chef for 29 years with the Veterans Administration; completing a religious studies degree and authoring a book, "Trouble Don't Last" based on his life.

Deacon Shelby is currently at Holy Spirit Catholic Church where his culinary background lead him to implement a number of programs including: the Repast Program committee, a Halloween party for youth, Community Meals program, the annual Parish Picnic and providing a full hot breakfast for PSR students and families. Also featured in the article are two of Deacon Shelby's recipes. Please take the time to read the article in its entirety. It is extremely inspirational and will give you a chance to know Deacon Shelby a little better.
