In 1979, the US Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) issued a pastoral letter that read, "Racism is a sin: a sin that divides the human family, blots out the image of God among specific members of that family, and violates the fundamental human dignity of those called to be children of the same Father." In 2018, the bishops issued a subsequent pastoral letter, *Open Wide Our Hearts: The Enduring Call to Love*. The bishops indicated that despite many promising strides made in our country, racism still infects our nation. The letter addresses a growing concern in our country based on a continuous history of discrimination and violence along with extreme nationalist ideologies.

In response to this call by the bishops, we are asking you to save the date - September 28th, 8:30 am - 4:00 pm to attend the Racism Conference sponsored by The Diocese of Cleveland and Catholic Charities.
