

# PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR) FIRST COMMUNION CLASS CONFIRMATION CLASS

Catholic school students are not only invited and welcomed to take part in our programs, but we also expect and hope that they do. One of the most compelling reasons to take part in PSR is to build relationships among fellow parishioners so that the strong community we have now will thrive into future generations.

### PSR Program

As in previous years, the program includes a three-hour day on every second Saturday of the month beginning with breakfast at 8:30 am; class begins at 9:00 am and ends at Noon. The first PSR class will be on Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup>.

### THE CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE CRISIS: OUR PARISH RESPONDS

The task force organizing our parish response met on Friday evening, July 12<sup>th</sup>. Two more parishioners asked to be a part of the planning and joined the planning meeting. As it stands now, the task force members are: Margot Williams, Evelyn James, Doreen Kelleher, Kathy Ewing, Father David, Walter Wenson and Carol Bugg.

They began the meeting by reviewing the parish-wide meeting held on June 30<sup>th</sup>, discussing impressions of the conversation, reviewing some notes that were taken and considering the suggestions for next steps. The respect and reverence in which people's participation at the parish-wide meeting was received and honored was noted and appreciated. We are good to each other.

The task force came up with some ideas for the next gathering of interested parishioners and each member is doing some background work in preparation for the next planning session on August 1<sup>st</sup>. At that meeting they will schedule and outline the next parish-wide conversation. Please watch this space for more details. Also please remember to pray for all who are victimized by this tragic scandal.

#### VIDEO RECORDING OF OUR SUNDAY MASS

There will be no video recording of the 10:15 Mass this weekend or next weekend because of personal schedules. If you know of people who regularly view our Sunday Mass, please let them know that there will not be a video available for these next two Sundays.

We have been recording that Mass since Passion Sunday of 2018, and have missed only one other Sunday. All the recordings

are available through our parish website and YouTube.

Back in March we began tracking the number of views the videos receive. Our weekly average is 67 views, with a high of 127 on First Communion Sunday and Mothers' Day, and a low of 34 on June 16<sup>th</sup>, the Feast of the Trinity and Fathers' Day. This does not include a record high 549 views of Father Akolla's ordination liturgy in Pittsburgh on June 15<sup>th</sup>.

Keep watching, and keep spreading the word that this service is available to those who cannot be physically present in church.
