

**PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR)
FIRST COMMUNION CLASS
CONFIRMATION CLASS**

Plans for these programs to begin again in the fall are underway. You will find registration forms at the church doors. The same form is used for all three programs. Our parish expectation is that a person enrolled in the first communion or confirmation class is also participating in the corresponding PSR level. Please use one registration form for each student as early as possible.

PSR is a program of faith formation for all of the youth of our parish. Catholic school students are not only invited and welcomed to take part in our programs, but we also expect and hope that they do. One of the most compelling reasons to take part in PSR is to build relationships among fellow parishioners so that the strong community we have now will thrive into future generations.

PSR PROGRAM

As in previous years, the program includes a three-hour day on every second Saturday of the month beginning with breakfast at 8:30 am; class begins at 9:00 am and ends at Noon. The first PSR class will be on Saturday, September 14th.

FIRST COMMUNION / CONFIRMATION CLASSES

A schedule of classes for first communion and confirmation is not yet finalized, but it's not too early to register.



Chloe Becker was upset when she realized she could not name a single African or African American saint. A junior at Magnificat High School in Rocky River, Ohio, Chloe was inspired to learn more about racial justice after attending a school-sponsored conference on racism. This led to the creation of a semester-long project, a mural depicting African American saints and holy people in contemporary clothing, holding up the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Chloe took a break from her summer vacation to talk to people about using the saints to fight racism, how her community has responded and why she chose to depict the saints in contemporary dress. In this mural, you may recognize resemblances to some of our own African American leaders who minister at local churches in Cleveland.
