**PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR)
NEW COMPONENTS FOR THIS YEAR**

Because we firmly believe that parents are the first and best teachers of their children in the ways of faith, our PSR staff wants to engage the families of our parish's PSR students in a new way this year.

After breakfast and once the students gather for an opening prayer for the day and then go to their classrooms, we are inviting the parents, grandparents, guardians of the students to stay in the breakfast room for about another 40 minutes or so.

During that time, two members of our PSR staff will engage the parents in conversation about the materials/curriculum that their young ones are following in the classrooms. The idea is that the family and the PSR staff are working in cooperation to raise our children in the ways and the practice of our faith. Because PSR meets only once a month for a few hours, there is so much material that cannot be covered in class. But there is valuable material there related to the Gospels we read during Sunday Mass.

After PSR breakfast please stick around for a little while to take a close look at the curriculum we're using. We believe that these materials will be a tremendous benefit to you in fulfilling your responsibility to raise your children in the ways of our faith.

Registration forms for PSR are available at the church doors. Please use one registration form for each student as early as possible.

Catholic school students are not only invited and welcomed to take part in our programs, but we also expect and hope that they do. One of the most compelling reasons to take part in PSR is to build relationships among fellow parishioners so that the strong community we have now will thrive into future generations.

The first PSR class is on Saturday, September 14th, beginning with a hot breakfast at 8:30 am. Class is from 9:00 am - Noon.
