

"The love of money is the root of all evil. Some men in their passion for it have strayed from the faith and have come to grief and great pain."

- 1 Timothy 6:10

All the hideousness of slavery, physical and emotional abuse, raping of women and children, and the separation of husbands and fathers from their families towards a culture of people is the realiza-

tion of what St. Paul must have meant in verse 10 when writing to Timothy. Often we forget that enslaving people was about commerce not hate. I couldn't help but question why Africans over all other people?

Paul goes on in verse 11 to instruct men of God to flee from the love of money, seek integrity, piety, faith, love, stead-fastness and a gentle spirit. To fight the good fight of faith. Are these the words that sustain our people? Words of obedience and faith that allows us to persevere, hope and continue to strive and achieve despite the physical affects and mental duress of slavery. I too had emotions of anger, inordinate sadness, confusion, disappointment and joy.



I've heard people say; "Slavery, just get over it." Understand that generations of environmental and psychological experiences rooted in slavery and slave mentality, manifests in the DNA of a culture of people for generations. We are reminded

everyday of enslavement when hate crimes occur, racial discrimination, unequal opportunities on the job, in schools, "red-lining" our neighborhoods, subtle and not so subtle comments that are rooted in slave mentality. Still I was joyful knowing that, while not always recognized, Africans and African Americans built and continue to build America. Now there is tangible proof for all the world to see.
