**THE CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE CRISIS**  
*Our Parish Responds*

The task force that has been coordinating this effort met this past Tuesday night. They reviewed the last town hall meeting at which Katlyn White of the Cleveland Rape Crisis Center made a presentation and spent a lot of time answering questions and responding to comments. The task force members observed again that her presentation was well-prepared and well-received. For the moment, there are no plans developing for another town hall meeting. Certain resources will be placed at the church doors — resources related to abuse and where you can turn if you have been abused or suspect that someone you know is being abused. Please feel free to take any of the materials and distribute them to whomever may benefit.

In the meantime, the members of the task force want to hear from the parishioners at large regarding further steps in this initiative. Remember, the parish began with a conversation about the child sexual abuse crisis when it has been perpetrated by clergy within the church, looking for ways to help heal the trauma; addressing that topic as adequately as possible remains a goal.

September's town hall conversation focused on recognizing the signs of current abuse and what to do when you suspect it.
