CELEBRATION OF THE FEAST OF THE EPHIPHANY AND

THE HOLY SPIRIT CHURCH ANNIVERSARY

The official evening prayer of the church today includes this antiphon:

Three mysteries mark this holy day: today the star leads the Magi to the infant Christ; today water is changed into wine for the wedding feast; today Christ wills to be baptized by John in the river Jordan to bring us salvation.

The feast of the Epiphany has never been only about the arrival of the three kings from a far-off land to offer their gifts and their worship to the newborn. You can see from the above prayer that Epiphany is also about Jesus changing water into wine (his first sign in the gospel of John), and his baptism (when the voice of the Father was heard coming from the heavens, and the Holy Spirit was visibly present).

In truth, Epiphany is about all the ways that God manifests himself in our world, all the ways he wants to be known and show his loving compassion. Keep an alert eye and heart for how God will be manifesting himself to you throughout 2020. They are all epiphanies. Happy feast and happy new year.

ON MASS REMEMBRANCES



The custom is centuries and centuries old: the custom of making an offering to one's priest with the request that he hold some person(s) or intention(s) in his heart when he celebrates Mass. Those intentions are listed in the parish bulletin every week on the first inside column

under "Mass Intentions." The donation becomes a part of the priest's remuneration, but he may never accept more than one offering a day. In the United States, the suggested donation is \$10, but it is only a recommendation. The priest must accept whatever is offered, whether more or less.

Additionally, canon law requires that one Saturday or Sunday Mass is always celebrated for the people of the parish, and there is no donation associated with that Mass. Canon law goes on to stipulate that a priest may not accept any requests beyond what he can fulfill within one year. When the requests exceed that time frame, he must distribute the Mass requests and the offering to other priests who can fulfill the obligation of praying Mass for a certain intention in a timely way.

For us Capuchins, that means sharing Mass requests and donations with our friaries that are not associated with parishes: houses of formation and education, or friaries in mission territories.

Our parish's Mass intentions are booked all the way into October 2020, and that is before accounting for all the requests that arrived for All Souls Day this past November. The All Souls Day remembrances will be shared with other friars who may be as nearby as Wickliffe and as far away as Papua New Guinea.

Regardless, please know that the church considers the obligation, which a priest accepts, of celebrating Mass for the intentions of God's people a serious commitment which must be fulfilled in a timely way.

Thank you for sharing your intentions and allowing me the privilege to hold your loved ones in my personal prayer during the Masses we celebrate here.


