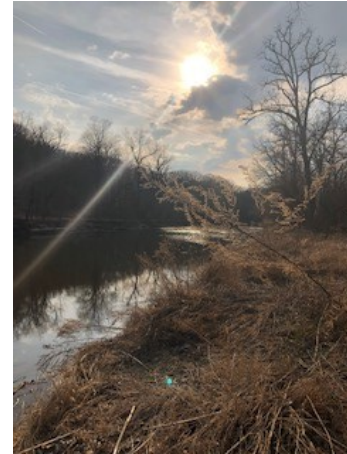
**Holy Spirit Parish

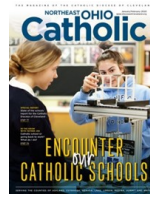
**SECOND COLLECTION**
