

# HOW TO VOTE DURING OHIO'S POSTPONEMENT OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION

The only way to vote in Ohio's primary election this spring is by absentee ballot. If you already voted, there is nothing else you need to do.

The deadline to request an absentee ballot is now less than one week away. You can vote by mail until April 27th, but ballot request forms must be received by the board of elections before noon on April 25th. Because elections board staff is reduced, the earlier you send in the request, the better.

If you are a registered voter, you should have received instructions from the board of elections on how to apply for an absentee ballot.

If you have not yet received these instructions, call your county's board of elections and request that a ballot be sent to you in the mail.

Voters must fill out the form, print it and mail it to their county board of elections. To find the mailing address for your county's board of elections, go to: https://www.ohiosos.gov/elections/elections-officials/county-boards-of-elections-directory/.

All completed ballots must be mailed by April 27th. You need to request that the post office apply a postmark to the envelope.

Don't miss this opportunity to have a voice in the selection of our public servants for the next term of office.
