

OUR SUNDAY OBLIGATION

Two weeks from now, June 5th and 6th, our obligation as members of the Catholic Church to attend Sunday Mass in person returns. This duty also includes attending Mass on Holy Days of Obligation. As always those who are ill, homebound, or otherwise unable to attend Mass are not required. People in these circumstances are encouraged to honor the Lord's day in some deliberate way, perhaps by participating in our livestreamed Mass.

Viewing a live-streamed Mass does not fulfill one's duty to attend Mass if that person is otherwise healthy enough to attend in person. Livestreaming is a convenience for those who are not obliged to attend in person for some serious reason. We will continue to broadcast our Mass in this way in the hope that we can maintain strong relationships with our members who cannot be physically present.

We will have two Masses beginning that weekend: 4:00 pm on Saturday the 5th, and 10:30 am on Sunday the 6th. We will follow this weekend schedule until we complete the parish-wide consultation and discernment of what Mass schedule best serves our parish community.

HOLY SPIRIT CHURCH TO BE A VACCINATION SITE

In cooperation with former Garfield Heights councilwoman, Ms. Shayla Davis, the Ohio Department of Health, the sergeant major of the U.S. Army Reserves, and the governor's office, Holy Spirit Church will be a Covid-19 vaccination site. A mobile unit will be set up in our parking lot on the north end of the parish center for walk-up service. The Pfizer vaccine will be administered.

The first dose will be available on Friday and Saturday, June 4th and 5th. The second dose will be given three weeks later on June 25th and 26th. The goal is to give 150 shots on Friday and 200 on Saturday.

No appointment is necessary. If anyone is interested in helping, we can use some volunteers to help at registration tables and directing traffic. We will also be looking for help in spreading the word throughout Garfield Heights and beyond by asking business owners to display and distribute flyers. More information will be forthcoming.

The vaccination has been approved for everyone 12 years of age and older. This will be an excellent opportunity to have children vaccinated; but anyone looking to receive the shots is welcome.
