If you want to vote by mail, you must fill out a separate application for an absentee ballot for each election. Copies of the application are at the church entrances. Please make sure that you do not miss the deadlines below.

- July 31 at 12:00 pm: special congressional primary
- October 30 at 12:00 pm: general election

- July 7-23: 8:00 - 5:00 pm & July 26-30: 8:00 - 7:00 pm
- July 31: 8:00 - 4:00 pm
- August 1: 1:00 - 5:00 pm
- August 2: 8:00 - 2:00 pm

*Special Congressional District - Additional Dates*

- August 2 - Absentee ballots must be postmarked on or before this date and received at the Board of Elections on or before 8/13/2021
- August 3: Primary election and absentee ballots returned in person due

**Municipal Primary Elections**

- August 17 - Start of early in-person voting and absentee voting
- September 11 - 12:00 pm: Application for absentee ballot to be mailed deadline
- September 13 - Absentee ballots must be postmarked on or before this date and received at the Board of Elections on or before 9/24/2021
- September 14: Municipal primary elections

- November 2: Special congressional district and municipal general election
