LIVESTREAMING CONTINUES

Even though we have returned to our obligation to attend Sunday Mass in person, we are still livestreaming the 10:30 Sunday Mass and the Wednesday evening Mass.

With some new equipment and additional personnel we are expanding what we are able to do. Other events and services can be livestreamed under the right conditions. This week's Night Prayer liturgies are an example. If you haven't checked out the livestream recently, please take a look. It's not only live, but a recording of the service is available almost immediately after the live feed ends.

REQUEST A PRAYER

There is now a new way you may submit a request for prayers. We've created a form on the website where you can make your request. Look for the "Forms" tab down the left side of the homepage. You can leave your request there anonymously; or you can give your name and contact information if you like.

Your intention will be remembered daily by Father David; and all our prayer intentions (officially submitted or not) are remembered in every liturgical celebration at Holy Spirit Church.

PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR) FIRST COMMUNION CLASS CONFIRMATION CLASS

Registration forms for these programs are available at all the church doors and on our website. The same form is used for all three programs. Our parish expectation is that a person enrolled in the first communion or confirmation class is also participating in the corresponding PSR level.

Please use one registration form for each student as soon as possible. PSR is a program of faith formation for all of the youth of our parish. Catholic school students are not only invited and welcomed to take part in our programs, but we also expect and hope that they do. One of the most compelling reasons to take part in PSR is to build relationships among fellow parishioners so that the strong community we have now will thrive into future generations.

PSR PROGRAM

A significant change this year is that PSR classes are meeting twice a month. A schedule of class dates has been finalized and is available on our website or from the parish office. The Pre-K and K-1 classes are gathering in person in the parish center; all the other grade levels are meeting in the teleconference mode, as last year. The exact time of each class session has yet to be determined.

FIRST COMMUNION / CONFIRMATION CLASSES

Please use the same registration form as for PSR to signup a student for these classes. The schedule of dates for classes and the manner of gathering is still being determined.

ON WEARING A FACE MASK

Please be aware that the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention is again recommending that everyone wear a protective face covering when indoors. While it is not a requirement, please consider your own safety and that of others when making your decision.

If you are eligible, please get vaccinated; it is far safer than taking your chances without a vaccination, and it's the surest way to put the threat of this virus behind us.
