PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION

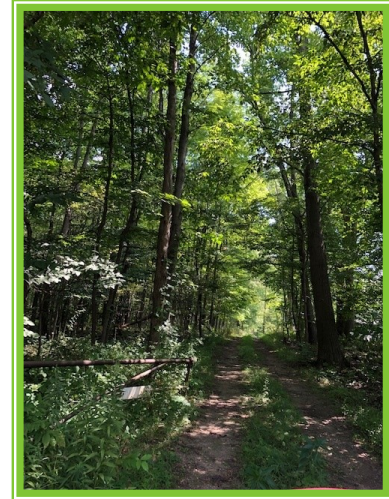
The first class is on Saturday, October 9th. Registration forms are available in church and on the website. That same registration form can be used for the First Communion and Confirmation classes.
