

The current phase of the synodal process culminates with what is called the Diocesan Pre-synodal Gathering. This gathering provides the opportunity for diverse synodal Church members of the diocese to come together for a liturgical celebration,

to pray, to reflect on their experience of the synodal process, to listen to feedback that has emerged from the listening sessions across the diocese, to dialogue about the current reality of the local church and the signs of the times, and to discern the Holy Spirit's call for northeast Ohio on the path of synodality. The Diocesan Presynodal Gathering takes place on Saturday, June 11th at the Cleveland Public Auditorium.

Every parish has been asked to name five delegates to participate in that gathering. In addition to our parish's facilitators of the process, the pastoral council named three other delegates. So, our five representatives to the June 11th event are:
