BEYOND THOUGHTS AND PRAYERS

When we promise our prayers, that is a sacred duty which we must fulfill to be people of our word. Turning to God for his grace and guidance in uncertain times is vitally necessary, but it is not all we can do. Especially when the problems we face are of human making, asking God to do all the work of fixing them is an abdication of our own responsibility.

The two letters prepared to accept signatures are still at the church doors:

- ◇ one letter to Bishop Malesic asks him to make an unequivocal public statement against the sin of racism and the degrading violence it fosters. We are asking him to boldly and unabashedly name racism and pledge the efforts of the Diocese of Cleveland to point it out and root it out.
- ◇ the second letter will be individually addressed to several congressional leaders and the president demanding meaningful action to address gun violence.

As of now, each letter has received over 50 signatures. They will remain available through this weekend and then the letters and signatures will be mailed. If you want to sign on, please do so today.
