Sisters and Brothers of Holy Spirit!

This Sunday, as well as every last Sunday in September since 1914, the Catholic Church celebrates the World Day of Migrants and Refugees (WDMR). It is set aside as a time to consider and pray for those who are facing different challenges in their homelands which have forced them to move to foreign lands seeking security for themselves and their families. As we remember this reality that many in our world face today we can think of Jesus' words to us in Matthew Gospel (25:35), *I was a stranger and you welcomed me*. Pope Francis has written a reflection on Jesus' instruction for this year's celebration:

These words are a constant admonition to see in the migrant not simply a brother or sister in difficulty, but Christ himself, who knocks at our door. Consequently, even as we work to ensure that in every case migration is the fruit of a free decision, we are called to show maximum respect for the dignity of each migrant; this entails accompanying and managing waves of migration as best we can, constructing bridges and not walls, expanding channels for a safe and regular migration. In whatever place we decide to build our future, in the country of our birth or elsewhere, the important thing is that there always be a community ready to welcome, protect, promote and integrate everyone, without distinctions and without excluding anyone. (Message of His Holiness PopeFrancis for the 109th World Day of Migrants and Refugees 2023)

Let us continue to *build bridges and not walls* at our Holy Spirit home. Let us continue to welcome the migrant, the refugee, the marginalized, the lost, the lonely, the forsaken, the excluded, the afraid. Let us pray that the Holy Spirit grant us wisdom, prudence, and courage to be the presence in today's world that Jesus calls us to be!
