ALL SAINTS AND ALL SOULS REMEMBRANCE

During the month of November, we are called to prayerfully remember those who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith. At Holy Spirit, we remember them with the perpetual burning of purple candles beside the tabernacle to serve as sign of our ceaseless prayers for the dead. Please use the All Souls Day envelope in your offertory packet to have a candle lit in memory of your beloved deceased (suggested donation \$5.00).

The Solemnity of All Saints (All Saints Day), a holy day of obligation, falls on Wednesday, November 1st, so we honor them during our regular Wednesday evening Mass at 6:30pm. We celebrate the souls of the saints in Heaven, both recognized by the church, and those souls that are unknown. We will have a **SPECIAL PRESENTATION OF THE LIVES OF SAINTS AND SAINTS-TO-BE BY OUR TEENS**. Please join our HS family and be inspired by our Catholic communion of Saints and Saints to be!

The Parish Commemoration of the Faithful Departed (All Souls Mass), for those who have died during the past year, will be on Sun, Nov 5th, 10:30am. Families of those whom we have celebrated the Funeral or Memorial Mass at Holy Spirit, and families whom have asked us to pray for their family members outside of the parish, are invited to honor the lives of all our dearly departed who sleep in the hope of resurrection. We offer prayerful support to members of our community and recognize our spiritual union as a church within the communion of saints. Family members of our departed brothers and sisters should receive an invitation, but you don't need an invitation to attend. It's a regular parish Mass and all are welcome to come and pray in a special way for deceased loved ones of every place, faith, and generation. May your beloved know God's mercy, light, and love, and may you be filled with the peace that only God can give. Our departed loved ones are honored by the calling of their names during the litany of prayers, a memorial display for the month of November, the Book of Life (by the St. Joseph statue), a Memorial Book, and Holiday Care Notes outside the chapel.

Catholic Cemeteries Sunday Mass will be at various cemeteries throughout the diocese on November 5th at 3:00pm. Cemetery Sunday is dedicated to prayers for our loved ones buried in a Catholic cemetery and is celebrated with a special Mass on cemetery grounds. 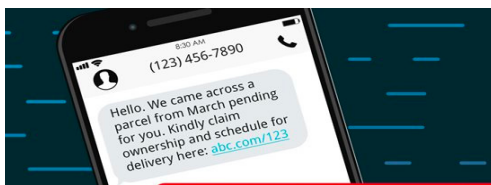

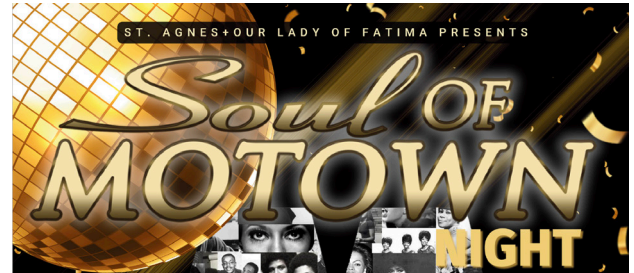
