Dear Holy Spirit Family! The Triduum and the Easter season heighten our sense of liturgy and its importance in our lives. As a Church we pray both privately (devotionally) and publically (liturgically). We develop our relationship with God *privately* as we pray throughout our day; in our homes, our neighborhoods, our workplaces, in times of crisis and in times of joy. However, these prayers are a preparation or warm-up for the “fount” of prayer from which all the Church’s power flows...the Liturgy of the Eucharist, the Sacred Liturgy, the Mass. The word *liturgy* comes from a Greek word meaning “the work of the people.” The priest begins our Eucharistic prayer saying *Pray, brothers and sisters, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father.* In the Eucharist we bring to the Lord our individual offerings, sufferings, prayers, and unite them to those of our brothers and sisters. This binds us as the mystical Body of Christ. Then, as we receive Jesus’s body, blood, soul, and divinity, we are united with Him as the Head of our Church! Let us give thanks today for the way Jesus gives us Himself as the source and summit of our life! -Fr Dave

SEEKING BEREAVEMENT FUNERAL USHER COORDINATOR AND VOLUNTEERS

Holy Spirit parish has a history of compassionate care in ministering to the needs of the bereaved, particularly at the Funeral/Memorial Mass or Service. Unfortunately, we have lost a number of our volunteers in recent years and we are now rebuilding this Ministry of Hospitality. We are first searching for someone who is able to lead the ministry of Funeral Ushers. This person will build a rotation of two or three teams of Hospitality Ministers for Funerals (ushers, lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, someone to carry the gifts forward, etc.) and call the list of volunteers when the need arises. The leader need not attend all funeral services. Second, we are seeking more Hospitality Minister volunteers for weekday and Saturday Funeral Masses/Services. You can volunteer to usher, lector, or serve as a Eucharistic Minister. The primary need we have is for Funeral Ushers to assist with the funeral program distribution (if funeral home permits), provide direction and care to the families, assist with the Communion procession, and clean up after the service. Please indicate your availability (weekdays, Saturdays, or both). Training in the Ministry of Consolation is required and will be provided for all volunteers. Please prayerfully consider and contact the parish office or Rhonda Abrams if you have an interest, want to commit, or if you have questions.
