Dear Sisters and Brothers of Holy Spirit, As this week's scripture readings speak about the sacrifice of Christ as the *One High Priest*, I wanted to share some portions of our Catechism of the Catholic Church to remind us of what His priesthood means for us all:

1544 Everything that the priesthood of the Old Covenant prefigured finds its fulfillment in Christ Jesus, the "one mediator between God and men."... "by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are sanctified,"that is, by the unique sacrifice of the cross. 1545 The redemptive sacrifice of Christ is unique, accomplished once for all; yet it is made present in the Eucharistic sacrifice of the Church. The same is true of the one priesthood of Christ; it is made present through the ministerial priesthood without diminishing the uniqueness of Christ's priesthood: "Only Christ is the true priest, the others being only his ministers." 1547 The ministerial or hierarchical priesthood of bishops and priests, and the common priesthood of all the faithful participate, "each in its own proper way, in the one priesthood of Christ." While being "ordered one to another," they differ essentially. In what sense? While the common priesthood of the faithful is exercised by the unfolding of baptismal grace - a life of faith, hope, and charity, a life

FAITH FORMATION AT HOLY SPIRIT CHURCH


