We are in need of a couple volunteers who either have experience with sound tech or are open to learning it that can help operate our Church sound system.

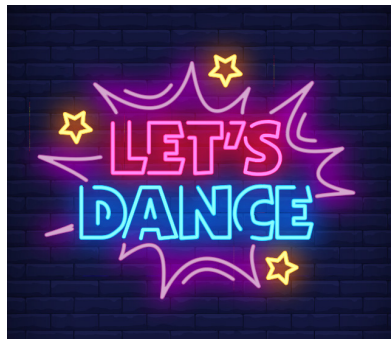
### MOBILE FOOD PANTRY DISTRIBUTION
