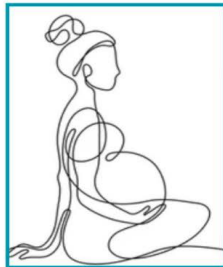

WHAT IS THE THEME OF THE EASTER SEASON?

The theme of the Easter Season is the celebration of the Paschal Mystery, above all Christ's Resurrection—his "passing from death to life" (Passover)—and how that Resurrection becomes our life and our hope. In particular, the Easter Season invites you to:

- 1) Relive the Resurrection as the center of the Christian faith, the "keystone of Christianity," made present in the Church's liturgy.
- 2) Receive the fruits of Easter through the sacraments, especially the sacraments of initiation (so that the faithful live the "new life" of the Risen Lord).
- 3) Experience a real "continuous resurrection" in daily life—faith in the Risen Christ transforming you interiorly and exteriorly, until the culmination of the season at Pentecost.

In short: Easter Season is a time of joy-filled renewal, grounded in the fact that Jesus is truly risen, and that his Resurrection guarantees and begins your own new life!
