*Jesus said to the Jewish crowds:
"I am the living bread that came down from heaven;
whoever eats this bread will live forever;
and the bread that I will give
is my flesh for the life of the world."*

John 6:51

Dear Holy Spirit Family,

These words of Jesus were cause for quarreling among the Jews that Jesus was speaking to. They asked "How can this man give us [his] flesh to eat?" (John 6:52). This is a fair question to ask when we use our human reasoning to try and understand. At the same time, we need to remember that God's ways are mysterious and beyond the ways we see and understand in this world. We are asked to seek understanding of God's higher ways through the eyes of faith. As we receive the Eucharist at Mass, we have faith in Jesus' words as He tells us *my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink...whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him.* (John 6:55-56). With this act of faith we take His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity into our lives and know His "sweet communion" in the depths of our soul. This is why "eucharist" means "to give thanks." We come to Jesus with thanksgiving as He humbly gives us Himself in an ordinary piece of bread and simple cup of wine!
